Approved or Restricted Technology

Residents are welcome to bring gaming, streaming, or smart devices to campus, but the device must be able to connect with an ethernet connection to use Park Central's network. To use wired devices, residents must register the MAC (network) address of the device to receive network connection via ethernet. See below for a list of approved or restricted devices on Park Central's network.

Network Devices

The PKC networks are owned, operated, and maintained by the BCS Technology Department. In order to maintain the integrity and security of the networks, only network devices approved and managed by the BCS Technology Department are allowed on the PKC networks. Consumer-grade network hubs and routers can disrupt the PKC network and can introduce serious security issues. The policy against connection of these unapproved devices is enforced campus-wide.

System Requirements

During the registration process, your device will be checked to ensure the operating system is current (including latest critical security patches), updated anti-virus software is installed, and the MAC address will be collected. Television Service

A basic cable TV package is provided in each apartment at no additional cost. For questions regarding the television service or to report a problem, call [The Ware's Front Desk](#) at (806) 337-4000.

Phone Service

Local phone service is provided in each apartment at no additional cost. A unique phone number is assigned to each apartment by the PKC phone systems. For questions regarding the phone service or to report a problem, call [The Ware's Front Desk](#) at (806) 337-4000.
